NEW YORK'S GASLESS SUNDAY.

(New York Times.)
Again Sunday found New York prac-
tically 100 per cent loyal to the fuel
administration's mandate that no vehicles
run by gasoline power be used for pleasure
purposes. Fifth avenue, Riverside
drive, and the bridges and highways
leading out of the city into the suburbs,
were comparatively deserted excepting
for horse-driven carriages and automobiles
carrying physicians' signs. Garages in
all parts of the city reported that they
had not sold a gallon of gasoline during
the day.
