MEMORIAL.

TO THE RIGHT REVEREND the Bishops, the Clergy and Laity of the Provincial Synod of the Ecclesiastical Province of Canada.

The MEMORIAL of the SYNOD of the DIOCESE of NIAGARA respectfully sheweth,

That in view of the importance of having one uniform Hymn Book in use in the Churches of this Ecclesiastical Province, this Synod desires to urge upon the Provincial Synod the taking of such steps as may to them seem most expedient for the accomplishment of this object.

This Memorial was unanimously adopted by the Synod of Niagara at its May session, 1877.
