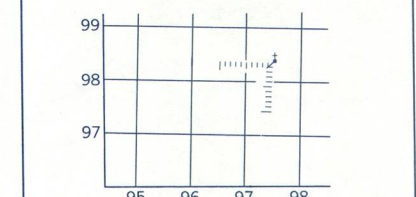

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP



REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH	(see above)
EASTING	Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line westward to point.	97 5 95
NORTHING	Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.	96 4 94

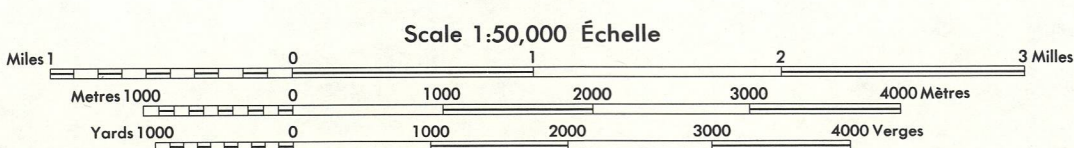
