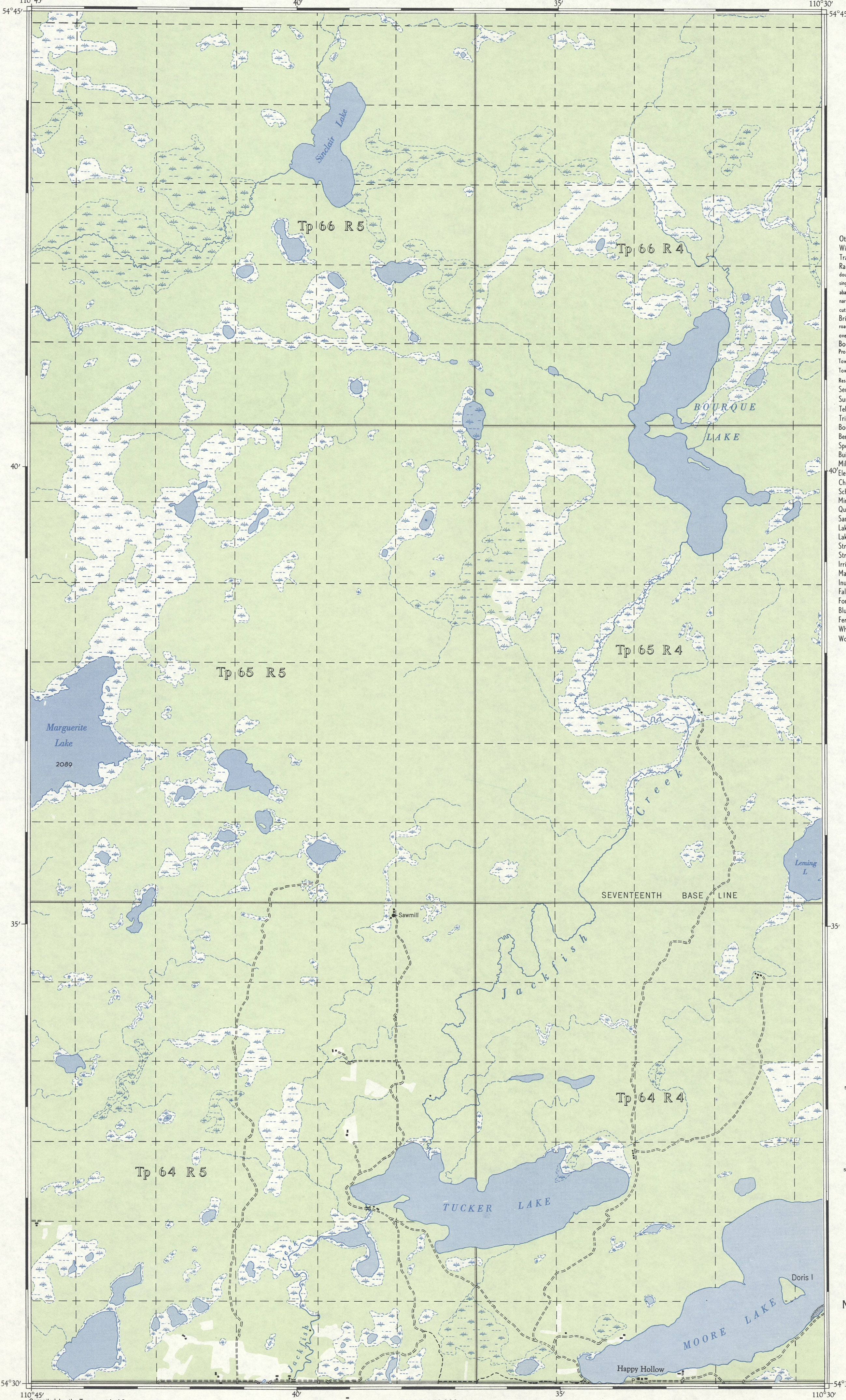

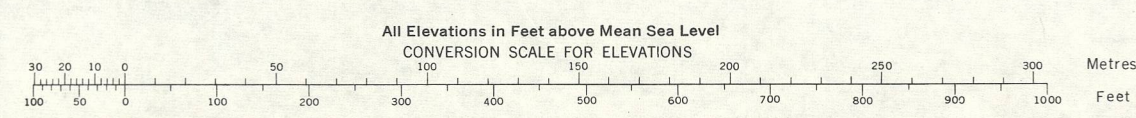
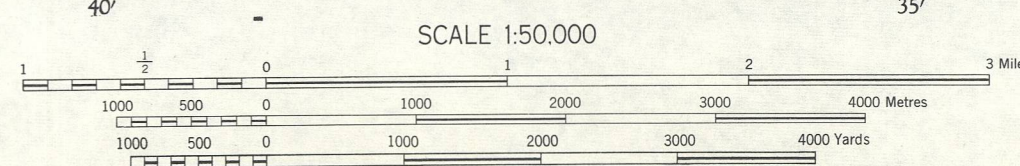
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 23° 44' EAST,
