

Bye-laws and regulations of the Edmundston sewerage system adopted September 10th A. D. 1918.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EDMUNDSTON AS FOLLOWS :

1. The Town Council shall appoint a Superintendent of Sewers, Engineer or Inspector who shall be under the direction and control of the Sewer Committee of the Town Council, and shall receive such remuneration for his services as shall be determined by the Town Council.

for inspection and cleaning. 28. All traps shall be protected from siphonage or air pressure by special vent pipes of cast iron, galvanized wrought iron, or brass, of not less than that of the waste pipes which they serve.

29. The special venting of the upper fixture may be omitted provided it is a water-closet and is located not more than three feet from the main ventilating stack. 30. Lead vent pipes may be used only when they are readily accessible for inspection, and in no case behind sheathing or within partitions.

31. Every water-closet or line of water-closets on the same floor shall be supplied with water from a tank or cistern and the flushing pipe shall not be less than one and one fourth inch diameter. Water-closets having earthenware traps shall be connected to soil pipes with a brass flange of floor plate soldered on the lead pipe.

32. No pan water-closet shall be fitted up in any building and no closet or other convenience shall be fitted up or used which allows the escape into the house of air or gas which has been confined in any part of it, or from the drain or soil pipe, or which allows the accumulation of filth in or about it.

33. Every water-closet located in a basement must be provided with a local vent. Such vent will be carried upward and into a heated flue or into a chimney chimney or in such other manner as the Superintendent, Engineer or Inspector, may direct.

34. All plumbing shall be tested by the water pressure in the presence of the Superintendent, Engineer or Inspector. Said test shall include all sewer, soil and vent pipe, lead branches, traps and ferrules joints.

35. No premises which are unconnected with and not being supplied with water from the Town Water Works System shall have the right, nor be allowed, to be connected with the sewerage system except by express permission in writing from the Town Clerk.
