Columbus, Ohio, Sept. 17.—First day's racing in the fall Grand Circuit meeting here today was featured by the excellent victory of Peter June, the high priced colt being campaigned by Geers, and the winning mile of Little Frank D. in 2:03 1/2, in the heat of the King Stake pace for 2-year-olds, which event was unfinished at sundown.

The Horse Review Futurity for two year old trotters brought a field of eight to the starter. Nella Dillon was the favorite in the auctions, the first heat and carried Peter June to the half in 1:01 1/2, the fastest half mile ever trotted in a race by a two year old. The sturdier Peter June, although tired at the city had more stamina left than Nella Dillon and he won the heat in 2:07 1/2, a new race record for two year olds this season. The second heat he trotted in 2:08 winning as he pleased.

A. Valentine drove Straight Salt to a straight heat victory in the 2:10 trot, beating Ima Jay, a heavily played favorite. Little Frank D. looked like an easier winner after his first two winning heats, in the King Stake, but could not stave off the Savoy in the sundown heat and the deciding mile went over until Tuesday.


