Diamond Cutters.
There are 25,000 diamond cutters and polishers in the world. Of these only about 675 are in the United States, and these have come mostly since the outbreak of the European war, which crippled the industry in Amsterdam and Antwerp, the world's greatest centres.

In the present year 36 diamond-cutting establishments in this country. This is exclusive of shops where all kinds of precious stones are cut.

The number of Germans employed as diamond cutters did not exceed 600 before the war, and of these only 75 per cent. worked for establishments in Germany.

During the war 600 or 700 Belgian cutters emigrated to England and organized as a branch of the London Diamond Cutters' union. They did work principally for Belgian and Russia houses.

Protecting Airplane Propellers
An aluminum plating for airplane propellers has been devised for the purpose of protecting the wood from the influence of the weather, which has been a serious problem heretofore. The plating is a thin leaf which is incorporated in the finish of the propellers, and the idea was developed by the forest products laboratory at Madison, Wis., and placed in production by the war department. The process is practically 100 per cent. effective in preventing absorption of water, particularly in the storage stage. A French authority states that 80 per cent. of the French propellers produced are rejected by the pilots mainly because they are out of balance.

This difficulty is due largely to unequal absorption or destruction of moisture and can be greatly reduced by an effective water-proofing coating.

Stopping a Great Waste.
Millions of dollars worth of fruit have been wasted in Florida during the quarter of a century. Hereafter nothing will be wasted as the drops, culls, and ripens will be utilized by new processes evolved by a clever chemist and scientist. The growers and the public generally will be helped by these processes as the former will reap a benefit from the sale of their waste products and the latter will have the benefit of the manufactured products which are greatly in demand.

Of the quaint marriage customs still surviving in old English an Scottish families one concerns the Dukes of Atholl and their heirs. The Duke always carries his bride across the threshold of Blair Castle in being in accord with an ancient tradition that it is unlucky for a bride to enter in the customary way.

England has a score or more of peacemakers in their own right who may become eligible to seats in the House of Lords, but it is likely that age or infirmities would keep at least three-fourths of the number from exercising their privilege.

Some of the nations have odd legends as to the origin of women. The Japanese believe she grew on a tree, the Laplanders that she was once a rabbit, the Persians that she fell from the heavens, and the Australians that she was once a toad.

The lot of the young wife in India is in many respects an irksome one. In certain parts of the country it is a common custom that a young wife, living, as she does, in a joint family of ten or twenty members, must never show her face to her husband's father, uncles, or older brothers, or talk with them.
