expenses of making or repairing any common sewer in any public street or highway within the said Town, and immediately in front of such real property respectively; and to 5 regulate the mode in which such assessment shall be collected and paid, and to make a By-law or By-laws for assessing the inhabitants residing in any particular street, or lane, square or section of the Town, in any 10 sum or sums necessary to meet the expenses of sweeping and watering the said street, lane, square or section of the said Town, provided that not less than two thirds of the said inhabitants residing as aforesaid in such 15 street, lane, square or section, shall have first prayed or demanded to have the same swept or watered; And provided also, that the Proviso. said assessment shall in no case exceed the amount of one farthing in the pound; and 20 generally to make all such laws as may be necessary and proper for carrying into execution the powers hereby vested or hereafter to be vested in the said Town Council or in any department or office thereof, for 25 the peace, welfare, safety and good government of the said Town, as they may from time to time deem expedient, such laws not being repugnant to this Act or the general laws of this Province: Provided always, that Proviso. 30 no person shall be subject to be fined more than ten pounds, for the breach of any Bylaw or regulation of the said Town, and in default of payment of such fine and of a sufficient distress being found for collection 35 thereof, to be imprisoned in the Common Gaol of the Colborne District, or other place of confinement, for a period of not more than thirty days.

XXI. And be it enacted, That it shall Board of 40 and may be lawful for the Town Council Health from time to time to appoint so many of the members thereof, or other fit and proper persons as they shall deem proper to form a Board of Health, to aid and assist the Mayor 45 of the Town of Peterboro to carry into ef-
