BILL.

An Act to limit the number of Executive Functionaries, and the Salaries to be accorded to each, and for other purposes relating to Appointments to Office.

WHEREAS it is of the essence of Free Preamble. Government, that the Administration of Public Affairs and the Expenditure of the Public Revenue should be left as little as 5 possible to the discretionary exercise of Ex-

ecutive authority :- Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of Committee of the same, That the Committee of the Exe- Executive Council to be

- 10 cutive Council in this Province, constituting reduced to five the Responsible Advisers of the Governor at a Salary of General in the ordinary administration of num, each. public affairs, be restrained to the number of Six; and that the Secretary of the Province,
- 15 the President of the Council, the Attorney General, the Receiver General, the Inspector General, and the Commissioner of Crown Lands for the time being, respectively, be ordinarily such Committee; and
- 20 that they shall respectively be entitled to take and receive for their services a sum not exceeding the rate of One Thousand Pounds each, by the year, to be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, by
