BILL.

An Act to correct an error in the Grand Trunk Arrangements Act, 1862.

WHEREAS a clerical error exists in the Grand Trunk Arrangements Act 1862: Therefore, for remedy thereof, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

5 1. In the place and stead of the words "sixty-one" in the fourth "Sixty-two" line of the eleventh section of The Grand Trunk Arrangements Act, substituted 1862, the words "sixty-two" shall be inserted, and the said section one" in fourth shall be read and construed as though the said words "sixty-two" line of 11th were and had been at the time of and ever since the passing of the sec of 25 Vic. 10 said Act, inserted in the place and stead of the said words "sixty-one." c. 56.
