D REGINA, SASK., June 28th, 1924

Sir:-

I beg to inform you that the Indians of the Kahkewistahaw Reserve have passed a resolution asking that a road grader and two slushers be purchased for the purpose of making roads and repairing grades on their reserve.

I may point out that the roads on this reserve have been almost impassable for the past year and something will have to be done. The cost of a grader and slushers should not be more than \$450.00. If you can see your way clear to authorize this to be paid out of Band Funds, I would be glad.

In addition to the above I would ask for authority to buy, say \$100.00 worth of provisions to be used to feed the Indians while they are at work. There will be no wages paid.
