Camp Borden, Ontario.	1/11/40		Flying washed out in afternoon. Visibility nil.	
	2/11/40		Wing Commander Middleton O/C Records visited the station. A concert party from station C.F.R.B. Toronto broadcasted from the theatre their programme "Around the Marble Arch" in the evening.	
	3/11/40		Sunday Routine.	
	4/11/40		Promotions. F/O's G.J.C.Reid, J.W.Reid, G.V.Priestly, A.T.Wilson, J.E.Fauquier to be F/Lts.	
	5/11/40		W/C Reid arrived on the station to visit Security Guard. Thunder storm at approx. 1800 hrs.	
	6/11/40		Colder and snow. Capt. Christie, Lt. Dahl, Lt. Barkald and Lt. Buluskin Royal Norwegian Air Force visited the station and were shown about by Sqn.Ldr. Blaine, Flt./Lt. Slemon and Flt./Lt. McClellan. They departed at 1630 hours for Toronto. Boxing and wrestling matches in drill hall in evening with showing RAF "March of Time" film in theatre afterwards.	
	7/11/40		Wing Commander Desmond-No. 1 T.C. visited station to locate site for proposed Explosives Depot.	
	8/11/40		Air raid on Camp Borden prosponed on account of poor visibity. Six camera men from various news reel companies in U.S. & Canada. The band held a very successful smoker in airmens mess.	
	9/11/40		All day till 1700 hours camp Borden was attacked by air for news-reel people from U.S. and Canada. Six Anson's arrived at approx. 1500 hours to aid in the destruction, kindly lent to us by Trenton, returning at 1730 hours to their home station. Seven oil paintings were hung in the Mess through the kindness of Mr. Burton of Simpsons on this date.
