

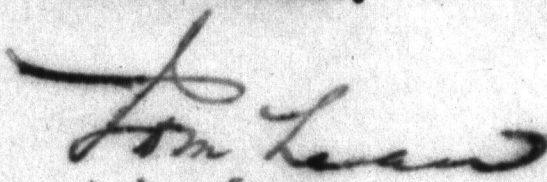

Sir,

The Department has received a letter from Dr P.E. Jones in regard to the loan of \$100.00 which he received from band funds. He asks for an extension of time in which to make re-payment, setting forth his reasons, which are partly due to ill health. He asks to be allowed to pay the first installment of \$50.00 in the fall of 1909 and the second in the fall of 1910 with interest. The Department desires to know whether you would recommend that the doctor's request be granted. You should also state whether the last year's rental <sup>(1908)</sup> ~~rent~~ will be paid in full by the tenant on Dr Jones' land. If so it will clear the amount of the loan.
