Rev. Sir,

In reference to your letter of the 16th September last in regard to the conduct of the teacher of the Whyoccomagh Indian school, I beg to say that the Department, in view of the explanations contained in your letter of the 15th ultimo, regarding the language used by you in your letter first above referred to, will accept your apology.

The investigation held by Mr Inspector Macrae into the charges laid by you against the teacher shows him to be unfit for the position and the Department would like you to notify him immediately that his services are no longer required, and you will be good enough to consult with the Public School Inspector with a view to obtaining the services of a duly qualified teacher to take charge of this school. The names of all applicants together with certificates and testimonials are to be submitted to the Department.
