
Ottawa, May 2, 1907.

The grant asked for by you, namely, \$15.16, for Pupil No. 078, Susan Sharphead, while she was in the Morley Hospital was not allowed. The Department pays all expenses at this hospital and considers that the school is not entitled to receive the grant for this pupil while absent from the school as a patient in the above-named hospital.
