Sutherland, who is acting under instructions from Department among the Indians on the Requis reserve, in the Province of Manitoba, reports among other things the case of advoung girl with tubercular spine and a case of a child with eye trouble which children cannot be properly treated in their home but whose parents refuse to permit them to be taken to a hospital for treatment.

I would be glad to be advised as to whather the Superintendent General could make regulations under the provisions of subsection (c), of section 32 of the Indian Act, as enseted by section 6. Chapter 25, 4-5 decree 7. for the compulsory removal of theses children to a hospital section of so whather the enclosed draft is a satisfactory.
