he may be called upon to take; that his work, however obscure
it may seem to himself or others, is, nevertheless, an essential
part of the whole, and that perfection in completion of a great
edifice, such as this, will be found only in the sense of duty
and skill revealed in the exection and performance of the minutest
details. I cannot better express to all concerned, what I know
all present will wish me to say, that we trust this building may
be worthy of the all-important part which the Bank of Canada may
be expected, through the years, to play in relation to the
financial, industrial, and social needs of the Dominion, and which
the building itself will have in the permanent adornment of the
Nation's Capital.
