The marginally-named soldier was convicted by Court-Martial at Camp Borden on the 14th of June, 45 on a charge of absenting himself without leave under Sec. 15(1) of the Army Act, and sentenced to 75 days imprisonment with hard labour and to be discharged with ignominy.

- The sentence is being served in the Ontario Reformatory at Guelph and the Superintendent thereof reports that the conduct and industry of this S.U.S. have been good and warrants a remission of sentence.
- The marginally-named was struck off strength A-10 CIRC to No. 1 District Depot on 7 July, 45 for discharge under C.A.R.O. 1029(9).
- The Commander, Camp Borden, is prepared to authorize remission of sentence of this soldier effective 1st of Aug. 45 in pursuance of the policy as to remission of sentences laid down in H.Q.C. 9039-1-1, dated 15 June 45.
- As no advice has been received to the effect that discharge has been carried out in this case, the D.O.C., M.D. 1 is requested, please, to remit the balance of the sentence effective 1st Aug. 45, or effective the same date as discharge in the event discharge has not been carried out by 1st Aug. 45.
- Herewith enclosed is Form of Remission, Parts I and II of which have been completed. It is requested that Parts III, IV and V be completed and the form forwarded directly to NDHQ with advice to this Headquarters.
