Statement of M1233 Sgt Leane, D.C. 44,
1 Cdr Lofc Terminal Sig Section, taken
2120 hrs 1st October 1944.

I hereby certify that I have been
duly warned and make the following
Statement voluntarily.

on Wednesday Sept 27th 1944 I
left Bethune at approx 0830 hrs driving
Ford 5wt 414. & M1453178 accompanied by
L22456 sgt McGillicuddy W.A. and proceeded to
Relle on duty. After working all morning
until 12 noon mil time we decided to stay in
Relle for dinner. We ate lunch at a place
with Cafe Restaurant on the window. We had
finished eating when six men at a nearby
table, or perhaps five men, beckoned us
over to their table. We were invited
and had some champagne with them
and were then asked if we could get them
some petrol. After a few questions back
and forth they agreed to pay any price
for gas. Conversation was mostly in English.
All spoke fairly good English with one
outstanding. Eventually we decided to sell
them some gas and a time and date were
set. The following day the gas was procured
and delivered at the time and place set.
We dears the petrol at 134 Pet Point Depot.
After meeting two of the men a price was
agreed on at four hundred francs per gallon.
There were fifty six cans in all the total
D.C. Leane 44.
