you full information on this matter you gave them a very poor hearing. This was somewhat discouraging and it would almost lead one to think that the Kitwancools were not desirous of having any real settlement of this question. I am pleased, however, to state that practically all other tribes of Indians in British Columbia are very glad to know that their long standing complaint is now within a measureable distance of settlement.
