FORWARDED 7-5-46. The case here refers to an aeroplane crash involving two persons as named in the caption. The cause of the accident is not definite, but it would appear that the man at the controls suffered a mental lapse, from which he has not fully recovered. Having been interviewed by the police, he has stated that he cannot remember anything about the accident, nor yet being in the plane.

This matter has been duly reported to the District Inspector for the Department of Transport, vide para 4, and the plane was owned by Aircraft Services (Western) Limited, Winnipeg, Manitoba, vide para 3.

File is still open to care for the eventuality of the injuries received by the two men proving fatal.
