23.—Pensioners should not hesitate to consult their District Office with regard to any matter on which they may have any doubt or uncertainty.

24.—District Offices are the connecting link between the pensioner and the Head Office. Pensioners may be assured that their enquiries will be treated with courtesy and attention, and every information and assistance possible will be given.

25.—Pensioners can always, in all cases, on all matters relating to pensions address enquiries to: "The Secretary, Board of Pension Commissioners for Canada, Ottawa." Pension number should be quoted.
