

CONSTITUTION.

PREAMBLE.

Agreeably to notice given from the pulpits of the Churches of the Canada Presbyterian Church, in Montreal, a numerous meeting of the Sabbath School teachers of these churches, took place in the vestry of the Free Church, Coté Street, on the evening of the 20th August, 1861, when it was unanimously agreed to form an association to further the interests of the Sabbath Schools of these Churches.

The meeting after deliberation, adopted the following Constitution, and then elected office-bearers, in accordance with the Constitution.

20th August, 1861.

1st. It was unanimously resolved, to form an association to be called the "Montreal Sabbath School Association of the Canada Presbyterian Church," and to be composed of the Superintendents, Teachers, Librarians, Visiting Committees and all members of Sessions connected with the Canada Presbyterian Church in Montreal, and its neighbourhood.
