

shall be under his management, assisted by the 1st Corporal; Squad No. 2, under 1st Sergeant and 2nd Corporal; Squad No. 3, under 2nd Sergeant and 3rd Corporal. It shall be his duty to have all notices or orders served that may emanate from the Captain or Board of Management. In his absence, the Senior Sergeant present, shall assume his duties.

ARTICLE V.

CIVIL OFFICERS.

SECTION 1.

The Civil Officers of the Company shall be—

A President, a Secretary-Treasurer, and a Board of Management, composed of the President, Secretary-Treasurer, and six Private Members. The Officers and Color Sergeant being (*ex Officio*,) Members of the Board.

SECTION 2.

President.—The President shall be elected at the annual meeting in January, and the quarterly meeting in July, to hold office for six current months. His election shall be, as all other Officers of the Company, by ballot. He shall preside at all meetings of the Company and Board of Management; shall maintain good order and decorum in accordance with the rules of order; (his decision being subject to an appeal to the meeting) said appeal to be conducted in the manner specified in the rules of order; and shall supervise all civil matters relating to the Company. In his absence the Senior Military Officer present, shall assume his duties and be vested with his powers.
