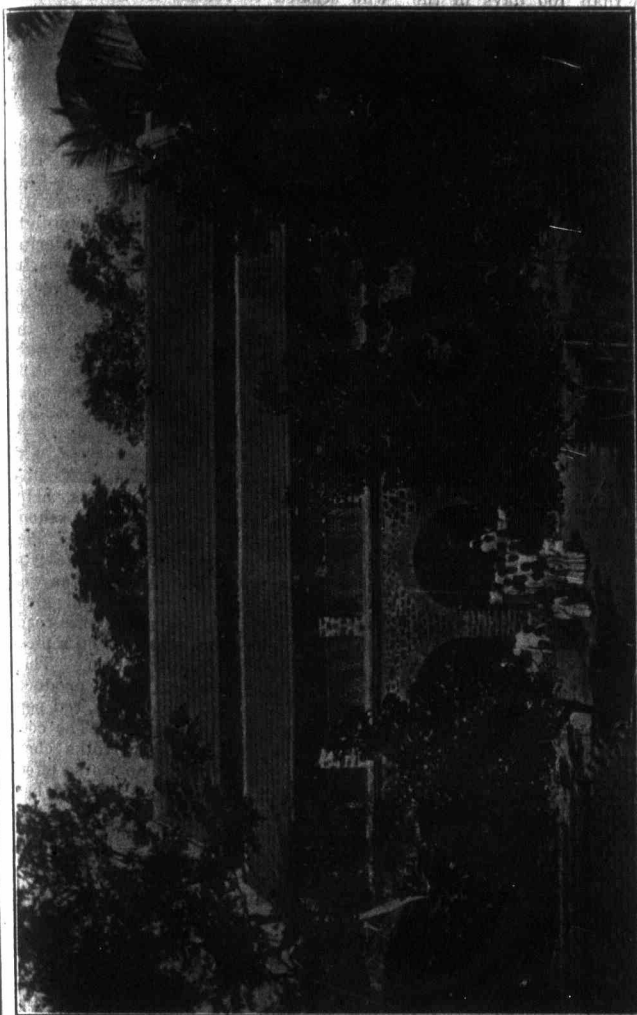




THE SARAH SIMPSON CASTE
