Importing Pure-bred Stock to United States.

Breeders of pure bred stock, desiring of sending animals to the United States, frequently write me for information in regard to the regulations governing the importation of Canadian stock into that country. For the benefit of such breeders the following summary of these regulations is given:

1. All animals imported into the United States from Canada must be accompanied by a health certificate from the owner or importer, declaring the purpose for which said animals are imported, viz., whether for breeding purposes, for milk production, for work or grazing, for slaughter, or whether they are horses intended for temporary stay as provided by the regulations. Said affidavit must be presented to the Collector of Customs at the port of entry, who will file it in the Bureau of Animal Industry in all cases where the regulations require an inspection to be made.

All animals imported into the United States for breeding purposes must be accompanied by a certificate from a Canadian official veterinarian, stating that no contagious disease affecting cattle, excepting tuberculosis and actinomycosis, has existed in the district in which the animals have been kept for six months preceding the date of importation. The owner must present a certificate to the animals in question.

3. A certificate for breeding purposes, milk production, grazing or for work must also show from tuberculosis test and free from actinomycosis, giving the date and description of the cattle with age and markings.

4. Any animals may be required to be inspected at the port of entry on the animal showing symptoms of tuberculosis, test, upon inspection from the chief of the Bureau of Animal Industry.
