

## Labor Party Loses Ground In the Municipal Elections Held in England Yesterday

Campaign Against the Increasing Burden of Local Taxes,  
Which it is Alleged to Be Due to the Extravagance  
of Labor Majorities at Councils

London, Oct. 2.—Municipal elections were held yesterday throughout the country, with the exception of the London borough, where polling only takes place every three years. The results show that the Labor party, which scored phenomenal success in the municipal elections last year, has met distinct losses in many districts. Labor lost seats in Bradford, Birmingham, Manchester, Liverpool, Accrington and Huddersfield, but made gains in Bristol and several minor industrial centers.

There has lately been a campaign against the increasing burden of local taxes throughout the country, which is alleged to be due to the extravagance of Labor majorities on the local councils.

A feature of the Liverpool elections was the gain of four seats there by the Irish Nationalists.

In Manchester the Conservatives gained four seats and lost two.

## SHERIFF COMPLETES SEIZURE OF BEER

Sheriff Threatened to Arrest

Sheriff Hawthorn is this afternoon completing the seizure under a writ of replevin of the 81 kegs of beer seized by Chief of Police Finley last Friday.

Yesterday afternoon forty odd kegs were seized and then Sheriff Hawthorn said he would finish taking over the balance of the beer which was in the police station when Chief Finley, who was away in St. John, returned home, as he wanted to serve the writ upon him.

During the seizure yesterday, Sheriff Hawthorn at one stage of the proceedings threatened to arrest Patrolman Alex Murray, who forbade him removing the beer, for interference, but later the trouble was smoothed over. Chief Finley returned to St. John last night and he would serve him with the writ this afternoon and remove the remaining kegs of beer.

In order to secure possession of the 81 kegs of beer under the writ of replevin the owners had to give bonds for \$1,000. The writ was issued by the King's Bench at the York Sittings here in January.
