## WHY GO TO CHURCH.

In the third place, it is an obligation we owe to others to sustain by our presence and interest a service which is indispensable to them; others, however, little we may mistakenly think we need ourselves. Again, it cannot be denied that an institution which Christ inaugurated and His apostles organized presumably has some merit. If they thought it worth while to establish the church, surely we ought to consider it worth suspending land transactions to those who come after us. Our Lord declared that where two or three are gathered together in His name he will be there in the midst of them. And so, if the church cannot be without benefit even to the most indifferent soul, centered soul, if there be any sensitiveness at all to spiritual impressions, it is a patriotic duty to attend and contribute to the support of the church. No one in his senses would think that the **WORLDS ARE TATTERED** by the extinction of the churches of Jesus Christ. No one would wish to live in a churchless community. The churches are lights in a world of darkness and our civilization, our laws, the safety of society, the **LOSS OF CIVIL LIBERTY**, and **LOSS OF THEIR FRUITFULNESS** of their fructifying and illuminating rays.
