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IMPERIAL PARLIAMENT.

An Imputation on Her Majesty's Use of the Prerogative.

LONDON, May 13.—In the House of Commons to-day, Mr. Dillwyn, Liberal member for the City of London, moved that it was necessary that the limits of the prerogative should be more strictly observed, and that Ministers, under cover of the supposed personal interpretation of the Sovereign, from withdrawing from the House of Commons, should be held to be in contempt of the House.

Mr. Cross, Home Secretary, announced that he was authorized to state that the letter of the Queen to Lady Fraser was merely a general expression of sympathy.

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NEWS FROM ABROAD.

EUROPE.

The cattle plague has appeared in St. Petersburg and vicinity.

There have been disorderly manifestations on the part of officers of the War Office in Constantinople in consequence of pay being in arrears.

The Vice-President of the Council on Monday stated in the Imperial House of Commons that various cattle cargoes recently from America were suffering from pleuro-pneumonia.

Intelligence from Tiflis says a disease with terrible mortality is raging in ten villages in the Caucasus. A mission proposed of holy pictures has been lately to the district of Gori, and prayers offered for the inhabitants.

The Berlin press comments favourably upon the military influence which Lord Dufferin has exercised in bringing about a general amnesty between Russia and England.

Roma, May 12.—At a Consistory to-day the Pope appointed Cardinal Frattini and three Cardinal Deacons. Among the new Cardinals are Rev. Dr. Newman, of England, and Rev. Dr. Hermestrom, of the Pope's immediate surroundings.

The Marquis of Harrington almost paraphrased Mr. Gladstone's declarations.
