> Convincing as these studies are of he excellent possibilities of preserving fresh fish by the freezing proess, they must not be allowed to lisguise the fact that they do not give a clean bill of health to animal issues removed from cold storage and exposed until sold or even kep ced in a common refrigerator. Neither can spoiled food be adequately preserved by any method. It is unfortunate that the efficiency of useful processes is sometimes impugned by unjustifiable applications of it. This has been true of cold storage.
