LONDON, April 22.

HARCOURT.

ST. PIERRE BULLETIN.

PARIS, via St. Pierre, April 21. Cannonading has been rather fierce n the Arras district between the Dise and Aisne, Meuse and Moselle, and in Mortmare Woods. Near Flirey Essey Road, not only did our attacks result in a progress, but two German counter-attacks, delivered on a line of trenches we occupy since 20th April, were repulsed. Belgian aviators threw bombs on Bruges Arsenai and the Aerodrome of Lessevech.

Midnight.—In Belgium the Germans attacked a trench captured by the British on summit 60 near Zwartelene. The enemy was repulsed, and lost on this point since 17th April from three to four thousand men. In the Argonne, near Bagatelle a fierce atack, purely local, was checked by our artillery fire. Between the Meuse and the Moselle we repulsed German attacks more or only reconnoitering parties, one in Ailly Wood, five in Mortmare Wood and one in LePretre Wood. We attacked the enemy north of Flirey and captured one of their trenches. We hen occupied same and connected it with trenches previously captured. Ground gained during the last few days extends on an uninterrupted front of over 700 metres. The enemy left over three hundred dead on the ground. In Lorraine there was an artillery contest. In Alsace we easily repulsed, east of Hartmannswillerkopf, an attack opened by a fierce cannonading. Our aeroplanes bombed in Woevre district the headquarters of General von Strantz, and a certain number of transport waggons in the Grand Duchy of Baden, also the electric station of Lorach.

> FRENCH GENERALS RETIRE. PARIS, April 22.

Twenty-nine more French Generals have been placed either on the reserve or retired lists, to give place to younger and more active men.

GERMAN ATTACKS REPULSED. PARIS, April 22.

Five attacks were made last night by German troops, attempting to recapture positions taken by the British at Hill No. 60, near Zillebeke. says a despatch received to-day from St. Omer, but all were repulsed with heavy loss. Three of these attacks were made within an hour. German reinforcements are reported rushing through Belgium to Flanders front. They are reserve troops said to number more than 200,000 men. The Germans have found it impossible to shift men from the Aisne, Champagne and Argonne fronts, because French artillery is keeping up bombardment in these regions, while French infantry is maintaining its offensive in the Woevre and in Al-

GERMANY'S FINANCIAL RESOUR-

HAVRE, April 22. A leading member of a famous banking firm, particularly well acquainted with the financial situation of the European States, has declared that Germany will be at the end of her financial resources by the middle of June next. The Germans have taken extremely severe measures in Belgium to prevent knowledge of the movements of their troops becoming known. Preparations have been made everywhere with a view to eventual retreat. High Prussian officers in Belgium do not disguise their despair, and admit that the German cause is lost.
