A Chance for the Men to Act

Editor Evening Telegram.

Dear Sir,—May I suggest, through the columns of your paper that now that the women have the vote they will use their influence to improve conditions in the Nursing profession.

At the present time at the General Hospital we have nurses working 12 hours a day—from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. vice versa. This means that a nurse has to be on her feet for at least ten hours per day, and as everybody knows that alone is quite a strain especially for young women ranging, for the most part, from twenty to twenty-five years of age.

But, besides walking around, the nurse does a hard day's work. The patients have to be washed, beds made, and wards swept. Meals have to be served, dressings made and applied, and laundry sorted. Add to these things the number of incidentals and you have the average day's work of a nurse. It is equal to, if not greater than, the amount of work done by an ordinary man.

Most hospitals in other countries have long ago adopted the eight hour day for nurses, and may I suggest that the proper authorities see that that be done here. It is bound to come sooner or later! Why not now?

Even the men have found that twelve hours a day were too long for them, and practically without exception now have an eight hour day.

Is it reasonable to suppose the women, who are not supposed to be able to stand as much as men, can work twelve hours? I do not think so!

I might add, moreover, that a Nurse's work is not over when she comes "off duty." Examinations are held periodically and in connection with these they have to attend lectures which are usually held outside working hours.

Personally I don't see how anybody can do justice to an examination based on lectures given after twelve hours' work.

In closing, I once more ask that those Suffragists, who have so lately gained the right to vote, will support the cause of their sisters.
