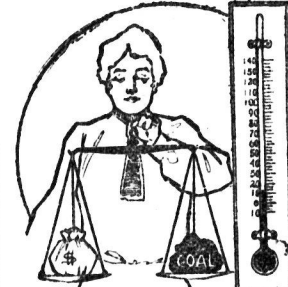

TUNNEL TOWN MAYOR IS W. A. HENDERSON

Elected on Platform Opposed to New School Grant.

Henderson, who ran on a ticket in opposition to the granting of \$45,000 for the erection of a new central school, with manual training and domestic science departments, was elected mayor by a major vote of 276 over P. It is expected that the school grant will be a bone of contention more or less throughout the year, as several of the members of the board of education are in favor of it.
