SIX OF ONE FAMILY DIE.

A TERRIBLE INSTANCE OF THE TERRORS OF SMALLPOX.

No Abatement in the Severity of the Plague.—The Board of Health returns a Case Reported.

MONTREAL, Oct. 14.—The official returns of the health office this morning show that there were 49 deaths from smallpox in the city yesterday.

A meeting of the civil board of health to-day it was resolved to ask the Montreal trustees of the college of physicians and surgeons to act as inspectors of the city hospitals.

A statement which has been prepared by the officials of the health department shows that of the 280 deaths from smallpox for the week ending Friday last, 263 were French Canadians.

A most shocking case in connection with the epidemic has just come to light. A hotel keeper in one of the outlying municipalities was reported to the central board of health as having a case of smallpox.
