**FARMING**

Amid the present depression and high rate of living the claimant call is heard "make the land yield more". We need a tide of immigration into our Province in order that vacant farms may be occupied and that more of our soil may be tilled. It is true that in large portions of Nova Scotia there is land that cannot be cultivated but yet there could be greater production.

We seem to lose sight of the fact and there is dignity in connection with the science of agriculture. We are told on the page of sacred story that King Uzziah loved husbandry, and there was a time in ancient history when Kings cared more for ploughmen than for soldiers.

We must have skilled farmers and we scarcely value them enough. The King himself is served by the field and the farmer is in the highest of all professions. The occupants of Eden were placed there to till the soil. The late Dr. Parker of London, once said, "Other men are in the air, or on the horizon, or at a great distance somewhere inventing possibilities for the description of what they are about, but the husbandman is just next to the Creator."

Our Agricultural College, Truro, is doing good work educating our people, elevating agriculture and stimulating greater interest in the tillage of the soil. The young men, especially natives of our Province, deserve ample encouragement and support that they may be led to look at the farmers' occupation as by no means a humiliating position. If we want our Province to make greater progress and increase the products of the soil, science must be introduced and help extended to our stalwart young men. Countries become prosperous and continue so and towns and cities grow and become stable when surrounded by an agricultural population.

Back to the land should be the modern cry and with increased volume it should be uttered today. Farming should be looked upon as one of the honorable positions in life. Let new markets be opened up for the disposal of products of the earth, and governments give due encouragement to the farmer's occupation. There should also be an influx of population of the husbandry class that our little Province may grow and become more productive. The farmer need not take off his hat to any man, and his occupation tends to clothe him with humility, and humiliation works out the most elevated joys. As the farmer takes off his coat and cultivates the soil he gives dignity to toil and dignifies the most ancient profession in the world.—Windsor Tribune.
