



A GOOD SOUR.—A knuckle of veal stewed in milk, with rice, very delicately flavoured with lemon peel, makes a nourishing broth when beef tea is disliked.

SALLY LUNN WITHOUT YRAST.—To a quart of flour add four eggs beaten up with one cup of sugar, one pint of warm milk, with a tablespoonful of melted butter in it, and two and a half teaspoonfuls of baking powder. Bake in "Turk's heads" like sweet cake, but serve hot for breakfast, putting it on the table whole.

A PEAR COMPOTE —Wipe, but do not peel the pears; steam them until they are tender, take them from the steamer, put them in a pudding dish; add enough water to almost but not quite cover them, and a cupful of sugar to a quart of pears. Set them in the oven for some fifteen to twenty minutes. Quinces are also nice served in this way, only they should be peeled and cup in halves.
