EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN CANADA AND DENMARK MODIFYING THE EXCHANGE OF NOTES OF SEPTEMBER 22 AND OCTOBER 14, 1949 CONCERNING VISAS

Sir,

On behalf of my Government and with reference to a Convention between Denmark, Findland, Norway and Sweden, signed on July 12, 1957 abolishing passport control at the internordic boundaries, I have the honour to propose that article 1 of the Agreement effected by the exchange of Notes of September 22 and October 14, 1949*, regarding visa requirements for Danish and Canadian citizens be revised to provide as follows:

- (1) (a) Canadian citizens who are bona fide non-immigrants in possession of valid national passports, and who enter Denmark from a country which is not a party to the above Convention, may, without previously obtaining Danish visas, visit Denmark for periods each not exceeding three consecutive months less the period or periods of stay in one or more of the Nordic countries during the six month period immediately prior to the entry into Denmark;
 - (b) Canadian citizens who are bona fide non-immigrants in possession of valid national passports, and who enter Denmark from a country which is a party to the above Convention, may, without previously obtaining Danish visas, visit Denmark for periods of three months less the period or periods of stay in one or more of the Nordic countries during the six month period immediately prior to entry into Denmark;
 - (c) Canadian citizens under (a) above who desire to extend their visits to Denmark beyond the three month period and Canadian citizens under (b) who, upon entry to Denmark or during their period of stay in Denmark, reach a combined period of stay in all Nordic countries of three months dating from the six month period prior to entry to Denmark, shall apply for visitor's permits in Denmark.

If the Canadian Government is agreeable to the above proposal, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement of September 22 and October 14, 1949 between
