- Contemporary sculpture (IMSS).

In addition, given the success of the presentations of Inuit arts and crafts in 1980 and 1983, the IMSS wishes to receive the collection once again for exhibition in 1985, as well as a sample from "Peoples of the Cedar".

The Canadian side took note of this interest.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

31. Canada stated that it would present the following exhibitions in Mexico in 1984: "A Time to Draw", consisting of 38 contemporary works on paper; "Leonard Brooks", beginning in May 1984; "Photo Canada"; and "Fall Reflexions".

The Mexican side took note of this.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

32. Mexico indicated its willingness to send the following exhibitions:

- Three Decades of Mexican Painting, in May and June of 1986 (INBA).

- Contemporary Mexican Photography (INBA).

- Pre-Columbian Art (INAH).
