India is a net exporter of fish and seafood products, however, a small quantity of preferred species are imported by bonded stores to cater to the diplomatic community resident in the country. According to Indian Government statistics, the country's total imports in 1992-93 were 27.8 tonnes of fish, fresh or frozen. Sources of supply for these imports were Japan (26.0 tonnes), and the United States (1.8 tonnes).

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
