

ARTICLE 6.


This Agreement shall enter into force on the first day of January of the year following that of the exchange of Notes confirming that each side has met all the constitutional and regulatory requirements necessary to implement the Agreement.

ARTICLE 7.


This Agreement shall remain in force for an indefinite period. However, either Government may, on or before June 30 of any calendar year, give notice of termination to the other Government. In such event, the Agreement shall cease to be effective for taxation years beginning on or after the first day of January in the calendar year next following that in which the notice is given.

WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, duly authorized thereto by their respective Governments, have signed the present Agreement.
