DEAR MINISTER,

I have the honour to refer to the Modus Vivendi applicable to the trade relations between Canada and Venezuela.

The Government of Canada considers that this Modus Vivendi has favoured the development of the trade relations between Canada and Venezuela. Therefore I have the honour to propose its renewal for a new period of one year as of 11 October 1971.

If Your Excellency's Government agrees with this proposition, the present Note, which is authentic in English and French, and Your Excellency's reply could constitute an agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of Venezuela which will lead to the renewal of the dispositions of the Modus Vivendi of 11 October 1950 for a new period of one year.

I avail myself of this opportunity to present to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
