## WARTIME DOCUMENTS PUBLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT

## OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the publication of <u>Documents on Canadian External Relations</u>, volume 10 (1944-45, Part I). Opening with a chapter on the conduct of external relations, the volume deals with policies related to the conduct of the war and to its immediate aftermath: the peace settlements, prisoners of war and internees, and economic relief for liberated and occupied territories. Volume 11, to come later, will deal with the creation of the United Nations and other aspects of post-war planning, and relations with the United States and other countries in the same period.

The editor of volume 10 is John F. Hilliker. A graduate of Queen's, Brown and the University of London, Dr. Hilliker is head of the Historical Section in the department's Academic Relations Division.

Documents on Canadian External Relations is a continuing series containing the most important documents on the development of Canadian foreign policy since the establishment of the Department of External Affairs in 1909.
