Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Financial Administration Act to authorize the deletion from the accounts of obligations or debts due to Her Majesty or claims by Her Majesty that do not exceed twenty-five dollars; to clarify the circumstances in which special warrants signed by the Governor General may be issued; to permit a Crown Corporation to establish a Receiver General account with ministerial approval and to authorize the payment of interest on money placed to the credit of such an account; and to provide for certain consequential changes in connection with the administration of the Act.
