Mr. MacFarlane has visited the Westmount Mountain property in company with Duggan, the occupant of the house thereon.

I have authorized MacFarlane to supply Duggan with the glass necessary to replace that broken. MacFarlane informs me that in addition to the broken windows a good part of the balcony has been destroyed. Duggan will repair that and also, at his own expense, paint the house this summer.

MacFarlane has instructed Duggan to pull down two sheds which are in a very dilapidated condition and are falling apart.

Signs will be erected at four places on the boundary of the property, stating that this belongs to the University and that trespassers will be prosecuted.
