PRINCIPLES OF THE IMPERIAL FEDERATION LEAGUE
AS ENUNCIATED AT A PRELIMINARY MEETING
OF THOSE FAVOURABLE TO THE FORMATION OF
A BRANCH OF THE LEAGUE IN TORONTO, HELD
ON DECEMBER 22ND, 1887.

1. That to the end that the Mother Country and the Colonies may remain perpetually under a common sovereignty, a United Empire in its foreign affairs, with constitutional liberty for every part as regards internal administration, a readjustment of the several constitutional authorities of the Empire should, as occasion arises, be made in such a manner as to increase the practical efficiency of Imperial unity.
