BERIAN, Jan. 1.—(By wireless to London.)—The total number of pris-oners of war held in Germany at the end of the year amounts to 8138 offi-

cers and 577,875 men. This is shown in a summary issued from headquarters today, which points ut that the list does not include civprisoners taken during the pursuit in Russian Poland, nor those in trans-

Pressian Poland, nor those in transport.

Of the above total the French contribute 3459 officers, including seven generals, and 215,905 men; the Russians, 3575 officers, of whom 18 are generals and 36,200 men; the Belgians, 612 officers, including three generals and 36,852 men, and the British, 492 officers and 18,828 men.
