

Hair, Gold, Silver, or Leather, being of the Growth, Product, and Manufacture of any the Dominions of the *French* King, should be imported into any Port or Place within the Kingdom of *England*, &c.

THE Effects of this Act were immediate and happy. The raw Wool of *England*, which before was a Drug, in a little time rose 50 *per Cent.* *Spanish* Wool from 20 to 28 Pence *per* Pound Weight; *Colchester* Bays from 16 Pence to 2 Shillings the Ell; and in a few Years the general Exportation of Woollen Goods rose from 900,000 *l. Sterl.* then, to double that Value; and in 1699, to no less than 2,932,292 *l. 17 s. 6 d. Sterl.* Dying Wares, whose Consumption depends upon the Demand for our Manufactures abroad, rose also upon this Prohibition; *Cochineal* from 15 to 28 Shillings *per* Pound; *Indigo-Lahor* from 3 *s.* to 4 *s. 9 d.* and *Logwood* from 13 to 19 Shillings the Hundred Weight.
