CATECHISM.

LESSON I.

*On God, and the Creation of the world.*

*Question.* WHO made the world?

*Answer.* GOD.

*Q.* Who is God?

*A.* The Creator and sovereign Lord of Heaven and earth, and of all things.

*Q.* How many Gods are there?

*A.* There is but one God, who will reward the good and punish the wicked.

*Q.* Where is God?

*A.* God is everywhere, but he is said principally to be in Heaven, where he manifests himself to the blessed.

*Q.* What is Heaven?

*A.* The kingdom of God's glory, and of his angels and saints.

*Q.* If God be everywhere, why do we not see him?

*A.* Because God is a pure spirit, having no body, and therefore cannot be seen by corporal eyes.

*Q.* Does God see us?

*A.* He does, and continually watches over us.

*Q.* Does God know all things?

*A.* Yes; *all things are naked and open to his eyes*, even our most secret thoughts and actions.

*Heb. iv. 13.*

*Q.* Will God judge our most secret thoughts and actions?

*A.* Yes; *and every idle word that men shall*
