of choice cattle offered, and the highest price quoted was \$18.90 per cwt., which was obtained by McDonald & Mayfield, of this city, for a pair of yearlings. The demand for good butcher stock was greater than the supply. The top offerings in this class were of light weight, 800 to 820 lbs., and were quoted at \$16.00 per cwt. The highest price quoted was \$14.45 per cwt., but there were no loads brought that price, and only three lots were quoted at \$4.40 per cwt.

Feeders and stockers were more plentiful, but there was not enough of this kind to supply the demand. The offerings were mostly from the past season, and were not prominent cattlemen in the market, amongst them John Smith, of Pelee County, and Jos. Fisher, of
