A country post office in the District of New Westminster, 22 miles south east of New Westminster, its nearest banking point, and 8 miles from Whonnock on the CPR, its nearest railroad station. It contains Anglican, Meth and Pres churches, and a public school, and is surrounded by a rich farming country. Stages weekly to Langley and New Westminster. Population, 100. Mail weekly. Gilbert Lawrence, postmaster.

ALERT BAY. A post office on Cormorant Island, off the northern coast, in the New Westminster District, about 230 miles north-west of Vancouver, the nearest banking and railroad point.
